

Residual Places

Subject to the availability of residual places students may be admitted to Years 1-5 and 8-10. Further information may be obtained from the School Registrar. A candidate who wishes to be considered for a residual place must complete the Application Form and send it to the School Registrar. Included with this application form should be a copy of the birth certificate, a copy of the most recent school report and a (non-returnable) entrance administration fee of £50. Cheques should be made payable to The Whitgift Foundation.

A candidate who wishes to be considered for entry into Years 1-5 will be required to spend a day in school and will be assessed as follows.

Areas to be assessed	Method of assessment
English Comprehension	Written test, interview, observation
English Writing	Informal observation
English Speaking	Informal discussion
Mathematics	Written test
Reasoning	Written test
Social Interaction	Observation
Parental support	Interview

A candidate who wishes to be considered for entry into Years 8-10 will be assessed as follows:

Areas to be assessed	Method of assessment
English	Written test, interview
Mathematics	Written test
Reasoning	Written tests, interview
Parental support	Interview

The most recent school report and a reference from the Head Teacher of the current school will also be used to assess suitability of candidates. When no places are currently available a waiting list is maintained in rank order.
